

Invitation to Negotiate Q&A Clay County Facility

Pace Center for Girls, Inc., a Florida not-for-profit corporation ("Pace"), is seeking competitive responses from qualified vendors ("Vendors") interested in the Invitation to Negotiate ("ITN") to construct a facility in Clay County. The following questions have been presented to date.

- What form of contract will be utilized to complete the project?
 Pace has a standard construction contract, but we are open to an AIA contract if provided by the contractor.
- 2. Does Pace intend to execute the requirements for tax exemption?

 Yes, a Direct Purchase Log will be needed. As for materials & equipment, contractors will order material and equipment and the invoices will be sent directly to Pace for payment.
- 3. When will the civil drawings be issued for the site work portion of the bid? We are estimating that this should be complete by early to mid-November. We will email the drawings when complete.
- 4. Can the list of bidders be shared with all contractors?

5. Can you supply a copy of the Asbestos survey/investigation report from this survey/investigation.

Yes, Pace will provide the survey upon request, but Pace will have the asbestos abated prior to contract award.

- 6. Will you be issuing a project manual/specification book for this project?
- 7. Do you have a finish schedule you can supply for this project?

 The finish schedule (material selections, brand, manufacturers) is not available at this time.
- 8. Are you open to product substitutions if they are equal or better than products listed in the construction drawings.

Yes. However, base your bid on the construction drawings. If preferred, a separate value engineered bid can be submitted.

9. Our bid package did not include the "construction cost sheet" that is mentioned in item 6 (a).

No attachment was meant to be sent. Construction cost/bid proposal to be provided by the General Contractor.

10. Our bid package did not include the "construction attachment" for the list of subcontractors.

Subcontractor list to be provided by general contractor, no attachment was to be included.

11. Is there a Request For Information deadline?

The deadline for a Request For Information is on November 18, 2019. The deadline for submitting a proposal is 11 a.m. on November 18, 2019. THERE WILL BE NO EXTENSIONS FOR THIS TIME AND DATE.

12. The plans show solid surface tops at multiple areas, but I could not find a spec. Is there a certain product we should price?

See sheet A0.0, under general finish notes. See note # 7, Corian, color: Designer white.

13. It appears the plans show a shower in bathroom 116, but plumbing does not show the drain and water supply. Are we to include the added plumbing required for the shower shown on the architectural plans?

Yes. The general contractor is to include the required drains, piping, water supply and valves for complete shower system in bathroom 116, as shown on architectural plans.
